Low vines, high planting density (10,000 feet/ha)

Vinification

Vinification with cold pre-fermentation maceration, pigeages at the beginning of fermentation and gentle reassembly to release tannins and phenolic compounds for 15 days.

This wine is aged 12 months in oak barrels with 30% new barrels.

Tasting

AGING About 15 years

This wine is very elegant, fine with a nice length in the finish. The fruity is combined with floral notes.
