Terroirs

VARIETY	100% Pinot Noir
AGE OF THE VINES	40 years
SURFACE	0,42 ha
SOIL TYPE	Silty, clay, sandy

Cultivation method

Low vines, high planting density (10,000 feet/ha)

Vinification

Vinification with cold pre-fermentation maceration, pigeages at the beginning of fermentation and gentle reassembly to release tannins and phenolic compounds for 15 days.

This wine is aged 12 months in oak barrels with 60% new barrels.

Tasting

AGING	About 18 years
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This wine is powerful with a nice length in the mouth, structured with velvety tannins and a beautiful finesse on the finish.
