Cultivation method

Low vines, high planting density (10,000 feet/ha)

Vinification

Vinification with cold pre-fermentation maceration, pigeages at the beginning of fermentation and gentle reassembly to release tannins and phenolic compounds for 15 days.

This wine is aged 12 months in oak barrels with 10% new barrels.

Tasting

AGING About 10 years

This wine, rich in aromas of ripe cherries, is well balanced with fine and elegant tannins, a very fine structure and a beautiful acidity.
